

Honey Analysis

- Sample Reference: Your reference: 11040
- Type of Honey: White Sainfoin honey from Kyrgyzstan
- Humidity Level: 14.1%
 - Method: Refractometry
 - Standard: Less than 20%
- pH Level: 3.70
 - Method: pH meter
 - Standard: Most honeys have a pH around 3.9–6.6
- Conductivity: 0.16 mS/cm
 - Method: Conductivity Measurement
 - Standard: Floral honey
- HMF Content: 1.7 mg/kg
 - Method: HMF Measurement

Pollen Analysis

- Dominant Pollens: Sainfoin pollen (90%)
- Secondary Pollens: Colza, Clover, Garlic, Asteraceae
- Others: Various plant tissues

Interpretation

This honey contains more than 90% sainfoin pollen, which is the classical marker of white honey from Kyrgyzstan.

The humidity is low which supports good preservation.

The low conductivity indicates a floral honey and the HMF level is very low, indicating fresh and non-heated honey.
